GRADUATION GIFT PROGRAM

As a graduate of Texas Wesleyan, it's time to leave your mark on the University starting with the Graduation Gift Program. This tradition continues with a dedicated purpose. Campus surveys have highlighted three areas where a little bit of money can have a lasting impact on Wesleyan: **campus beautification, campus technology and student scholarships**. As a graduate, you can make a gift to the area of your choice. Pay now or make a pledge to complete your gift within a year.

The number of participants and amount pledged is announced at Robing and presented as a gift to President Jeffcoat. The May 2009 graduating class gave \$2300. As you approach graduation, we hope you will take a minute to think about what Wesleyan has given you and what you can give back ... and also how you can beat last semester's gift!

Graduation Gift Recognition:

A PLEDGE OF \$25 OR MORE: Enables you to acknowledge **two people** (faculty, family, friends, etc.) who have impacted your college career. The Alumni Office will forward a certificate to your honorees when they receive your pledge. Just as your diploma makes your degree "official" these certificates make your thank you "official." These names will appear in the Robing Program under *The Graduation Gift Program* section.

A PLEDGE OF \$100 OR MORE: Enables you to acknowledge **two people** with certificates upon receipt of your pledge (as described above). **It also qualifies you to receive a personalized brick in the Donor Brick Walkway in front of the West Library (once you have completed your pledge)**. After making your contribution, you will receive a brick form containing inscription instructions that will be mailed at the close of the fiscal year. Complete the form and return it to our office. (In order to receive your brick at the dedication ceremony in October, your pledge must be paid in full by May 31, 2010; otherwise, you will receive your brick the subsequent year.)

The \$100 brick level is a special recognition program available only to seniors and graduate students through the Graduation Gift Program. In subsequent years, alumni gifts of \$200 or more are recognized with donor bricks.

For your commitment to be counted in the gift presented to President Jeffcoat at Robing, you must return this form to DeAwna Wood in the Office of Advancement & Alumni Relations by December 4, 2009.
