ANNOUNCEMENT: Texas Wesleyan University has been awarded a grant for conducting a physical science Discovery Science Workshop for elementary and middle school teachers. Wesleyan is currently accepting applications. This is the eighteenth year that Wesleyan has offered these workshops.

A total of twenty teachers may participate. If you are interested, I encourage you to fill out the application form attached and return it immediately.

CONTENT: The workshop will cover **Essentials of Physical Science: Air, Space & Flight/Weather Patterns**.

EMPHASIS: The workshop will emphasize building content knowledge, hands-on activities and *materials to be taken to your classroom*. It will provide opportunities to match hands-on science activities to math, reading, and writing TAKS objectives for your grade level developing your students' performance in those areas as well.

LEVEL: The workshop does not assume previous university level preparation in the physical sciences. Its focus is on material useful to the elementary and middle school teacher.

CREDIT: The workshop carries with it six hours of graduate level credit in natural science which can be applied to a master's degree if desired.

COST: None.

STIPEND: The grant provides a \$350 summer stipend and reimbursement for meals and travel (both calculated by T.Q. program). If the budget permits, an additional \$300 stipend may be awarded to FWISD teachers by the district.

DATES: The workshop is conducted in three weeks (1:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.) in the summer Monday through Friday from **June 10 to July 1**, and **on Saturday mornings during the Fall & Spring terms** (about 14 meetings will be scheduled in cooperation with the participants early in the workshop).

DEADLINE: Please return applications as soon as possible. Current interest indicates the workshop will fill quickly.
