TEXAS WESLEYAN HOSTS MATH AND SCIENCE PROGRAM FOR 7TH - 10TH GRADERS

Texas Wesleyan University will be hosting TexPREP 2006, an eight-week summer program for 7th-10th graders living in Tarrant County area and interested in careers related to mathematics, science and engineering. The registration deadline is March 1. The program, which runs from June 6 through July 27, will be 8:45 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Thursday with field trips on Friday.

Students will study logic, introductory engineering, mathematics and computer science. TexPREP students will do engineering-related projects; computer science including PowerPoint, Visual Basic, and developing algorithms; and meet and talk with professional engineers and scientists. Students are responsible for their own lunch.

There is no charge to the students. Transportation is provided for students attending schools in the Fort Worth Independent School District. The Texas Education Agency approves school districts granting one elective credit towards graduation for successful completion of the TexPREP program.

Application deadline is March 1, 2006.
