THEATRE WESLEYAN PRESENTS "PROOF"

Theatre Wesleyan will present the Pulitzer Prize-winning play "Proof," written by David Auburn and directed by Wesleyan senior Patrick James, at 7:30 p.m. Feb. 16-18 and 23-25, and at 2 p.m. Feb. 19. "Proof" examines the dual nature of genius and madness, and the familial relationships intertwined within. Dillon Maroney, a freshman at Texas Wesleyan, is Robert, an elderly man struggling to recapture the mathematical genius he achieved as a young man. Senior Angela Brown is Catherine, Robert's daughter and struggling with genius – and perhaps madness – of her own. Senior Eric Briggs plays Hal, Robert's young protégé who befriends Catherine. Wesleyan senior Rhealyn McMillan completes the cast as Claire, Catherine's estranged sister.

Produced by Connie Whitt-Lambert, chair of the Theatre Department at Texas Wesleyan, "Proof" will be performed at the Thad Smotherman Theatre.
