### **Computer Replacement Program Begins**

The Computer Replacement Program is now underway. This program, designed to ensure that computing resources at TW are adequate and able to function within the network environment, is in its first year of execution. This year, 73 vintage machines will be replaced with new University-Standard Desktop Computers.

Deployment of the computers to the TW offices, labs, classrooms, and work areas identified in the [2006 – 2007 Computer Replacement List](#) will begin on July 13<sup>th</sup>. All machines are expected to be deployed by August 15<sup>th</sup>.

It is the hope of ICT and the University Technology Planning Committee, the originators of the program, that within three years all vintage and obsolete university computers will be replaced with new machines. And this cycle of regular replacement will continue thereafter.

Computer Replacement follows the policy and procedure described in the *Computer Replacement Program Policy*. This document is available for review online through the ICT Web site.
