One issue faced by any group trying to complete professional tasks is finding adequate funds to do so. Implementing a technology strategic plan is no different.

During the last meeting, the committee openly discussed the plan projects and their associated costs and came to the conclusion that monetary support for

acquiring, updating, and maintaining hardware and software, as well as, money for professional development opportunities should become a priority for the Texas Wesleyan (TW) community. The committee concluded that full funding could be acquired by utilizing a variety of university, private, state, federal, and local sources.

The issue of funding for the UTSP is being brought before the Senior Executive Committee by William Bleibdrey, VP of Finance and Administration, and Allen Henderson, Provost.
