After an hour and a half of discussions and proposals for minor modifications, the members of the University Technology Planning Committee (UTPC) voted 10-0\* to make the current plan draft the operating technology plan for the university.

Broad participation, significant collaborative work, and extensive

stakeholder input were the hallmarks of the planning process. In all, over 450 members of the university community participated in surveys, focus groups, on planning committees, or as reviewers of the planning document.

These efforts, taking two years in total, allowed for the development of a plan that will prepare

TW to meet the technological demands of all its stakeholders.
